

- mainly driven by increased prices






A weak NOK is helpful..




Continued decrease in global supply of whitefish in 2019


Global supply of Atlantic cod 2019

The demand for cured products are less sensitive to price changes




Demand elasticities for cod in measured on export level (Norway)

	Price elasticity	
Clipfish	-0,69	
Saltfish	-0,67	
Stockfish	-0,85	
Frozen whole	-2,42	
Frozen filet	-1,26	
Fresh filet	-1,85	
Fresh whole	-0,77	

A 10 % increase in the price of Clipfish Reduces the quantity demanded by 7%

Trade flow of cod to Portugal in 2017




Most of the Cod consumed is Norwegian
