Entry to Norway for Seafood Inspectors

Seafood inspectors are granted entry to Norway, regardless of the country from which the inspector in question travels. This is stated in section 3p in FOR-2020-07-13-1553: Regulations relating to entry restrictions for foreign nationals out of concern for public health, dated July 15th 2020. The relevant section allows foreign nationals with technical qualifications entry to Norway.

The Norwegian Seafood Federation has received confirmation from the Norwegian authorities that seafood inspectors are considered to be foreign nationals with technical qualifications, as stated in section 3p in FOR-2020-07-13-1553. The Norwegian Seafood Federation can also confirm that the regulations have been practiced as intended, as seafood inspectors from outside the European Economic Area (EEA) have entered Norway without any problems or delay.
