In recent years, the Fishery industry is required to modernize due to changes in the fishing environment, aging fishermen and labor shortages. The FishNext Technology Expo supports the modernization of the fishery industry and the sustainable fishery industry by introducing the latest technologies and ideas such as Al, IoT, and robotics technology to fisheries companies and fisheries sites.

Sanitation Management Expo

Targeted Visitors: Seafood and food processors, Fishermen, Fish farmers, Retailers, Restaurants, etc

Due to the revision of the Food Sanitation Act, hygiene management in line with HACCP has been fully institutionalized from June 2021 for all businesses that handle food. In a survey of HACCP introduction status conducted by the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (October 2020), 42.7% of food business operators answered that HACCP had been introduced, and 17.7% answered that it was in the process of being introduced. Approximately 60% of them have not yet been introduced. With the aim of improving hygiene at food sites in Japan and strengthening exports of Japanese agricultural, forestry and fishery products, we will set up a "hygiene management promotion corner" and work to promote hygiene management in line with HACCP.
